Taras, or perhaps better known by its Roman name Tarentum, was an ancient Spartan colony in southern Italy. In all of Magna Graecia, the Tarentine Mint was one of the more prolific mints, producing silver coinage as early as the late 6th century BC. The reverse depicts a man, likely Taras, the son of sea god Poseidon and nymph Satyrion. One founding myth of the city tells of Taras being stranded on an island, with his father rescuing him by sending a dolphin for his son to ride on. The dolphin carried Taras to the southern end of Italy, into what is now known as the Gulf of Taranto. Where he landed is where Taras was founded.

Taras and the dolphin iconography is depicted on the majority of Tarentine coinage and was paired with a variety of reverses in the fifth century BC. The most well-known variety are various depictions of horsemen, either military or athletic. After the introduction to this reverse, the next two centuries focused on the horseman/dolphin-rider iconography. This extensive series of horsemen reverses has been a favorite for collectors to engage in and find as many as they can.

The issues the mint encountered with the Jubilee coins are well documented and were exacerbated by the pressure for the coins to be ready for the Queen's Golden Jubilee on 20 June 1887. Records show that 1,771,425 half-sovereigns were struck in 1887, but only 871,770, less than 50% of the total, were fit for circulation. To improve metal flow silver was included in the alloy, which makes all 1887 London Jubilee head half-sovereigns stand out for their lighter colour. The California Gold Rush (1848-1855) brought hundreds of thousands of people worldwide to the fields of the California Territory in search for riches. With the sudden boom in population, the area needed a currency system for the buying and selling of goods. The San Francisco Mint was not established until 1854—and not in full production until two years later—and the federal assay office, established in 1851, was restricted to only coining 50 dollar ingots as their lowest denomination. Despite their restrictions lifting one year later, the assay office only then went as low as 10 dollars (a piece colloquially called the eagle). Private bankers helped with a 5 dollar coin, but there still remained a strong need for smaller coinage, as the original payment format of pinches of gold dust was not sufficient.

In 1852, a few California jewellers began striking their own small denominations—1 dollar, 50 cents, and 25 cents—to meet this need. Of course, there was no regulation and intrinsic value varied between jewellers (and perhaps rounds of production), but with the boom of the Californian economy and the demand for smaller denominations, they were accepted. Despite the fact that they were private coinage, the coins assimilated the look of official US coins. Production of circulated fractional gold ceased around 1856, likely when the Mint became more functional and released federally sanctioned silver coinage. Fractional coins of this period (known as Period One) can be found dated or undated, and some with jeweller "mintmarks", that is, their initials. Three years later in 1859, fractional coins were reproduced, issuing in Period Two (1859-1882) of California fractional gold. Although reasons are uncertain, the coins may have been struck—now often very debased—for souvenirs. The gold rush was primarily over, but California was now left a thriving cultural melting pot of Americans and foreigners. Tourism from the East and Europe was now streaming in, and Period Two coins were the perfect collectable, and the jewellers experimented more with shape, putting them in jewellery, and muling old dies together.

The US Secret Service got wind of these coins, and, despite not currently used as legal tender, a crackdown on fractional coins was initiated, as the Secret Service viewed the pieces as a violation of the law which prohibited private coinage. As the souvenirs were still in demand, jewellers and other fractional coin makers then turned their productions covert; the underground production of fractional coins is considered Period Three. Period Three coins are backdated to avoid prosecution. The initial popularity for fractional gold ended after the 1880s, but resurgence happened in the mid-20th century (although normally of higher gold content of the original).

The Queen depicted as Una and the Lion was a controversial design issued at a time of great uncertainty. Victoria had only just turned 18 when she became Queen and Empress of the world's leading empire at the time, with dominions scattered around the globe. All eyes were on her to deliver the huge task of leading the empire to future prosperity. The depiction of Victoria as Lady Una, calmly directing the enormous beast by her side, the Lion (representing England), was a clever analogy, using the characters from Edmund Spenser's poem The Faerie Queene (written in 1590). It was the first time in history a British monarch was depicted on a coin as a fictional character.

As part of the Great Engravers series the coin offered here has caused equal amounts of admiration and frustration due to the low mintage and low-profile marketing from the Royal Mint. The mintage being just 225 pieces, it was immediately sold out and shortly thereafter coins were selling for multiples of the issue price on the secondary market. The Una and the Lion design is perhaps the most iconic of all British coin designs. The original 5 Pound piece struck for Queen Victoria in 1839 has been one of the best performers of all British investment coins but its performance now eclipsed by its modern version, leaving most collectors with little chance of ever getting one. This will be one to keep for the future.
