- Accompanied by a staggering provenance of the most illustrious collections, including Montagu and Slaney, with records dating to 1887 The 1687 Elephant and Castle Five Guinea Piece is among a class of coin that is both highly sought after and seldom offered for sale. Owning any example is a great numismatic feat, more often dreamt than lived. This example is the SPINK catalogue coin and undisputedly the very best example of the issue. Time and time again, collectors who have wished to assemble the finest and most important of collections, such as Montagu in the 19th century, or Slaney in the 20th, have found themselves purchasing this exact coin and for the first time in two decades this coin is courting suitors.

Despite featuring one of the most artistically rich portraits, coins of James II are somewhat of a rarity for two reasons: firstly, the brevity and unpopularity

denominations such as a five guinea piece, leaves them extremely susceptible to being melted down or repurposed throughout their journey to us. The relatively few examples we have left are fought over by collectors and investors alike.

The elephant and castle hallmark gives a historic depth and connection to this coin that is quite exceptional. A hallmark denotes that the metal content of a coin is from a particularly notable source such as war plunder or newly discovered mines. It is a device scarcely utilised in British coinage and evokes thoughts of modern commemorative issues, except in these instances the coins themselves are struck of the very history they wish to commemorate. Similar issues are coins of 1703 wearing a VIGO hallmark denoting they were struck with captured Spanish bullion, and the 'CAL.' quarter eagles of 1848 proudly struck with California gold. The symbol seen below the truncation of this coin however - an elephant supporting a castle upon its back – denotes that its gold content was exploited by the Royal African Company from the newly-discovered gold fields of West Africa. By the time this coin was struck, however, the mining operation was secondary to a far more profitable monopoly that the company held on slave trading along the coast of Western Africa. James II was a majority shareholder in the enterprise and, aware of the cruel, murderous, and dehumanising practises of the company, profited immensely from the booming trade of precious metals and enslaved lives. This coin was struck at the beginnings of centuries of devastation and exploitation to be left in the wake of Western progress. A difference between this coin and most others though is that it does not hide the exploitation it has been birthed from and authentically wears what it is for all to see. To throw a sheet over the prevalent evils of human history would be to repeat these mistakes again and ignore the progress still to be made.

A coin's beauty is in its condition. This coin's striated surfaces exhibit a dazzling lustre, rich tone, and areas of strong mirroring. With only light handling and haymarks, this example is the highest graded by both NGC and PCGS by two full grades, with only two other examples having graded mint state (MS60 and 61, both NGC). But the most striking feature of this coin is how exceptionally well struck it is. The James II bust is a masterclass in fine workmanship and intricate detail executed by veteran engraver John Roettiers (1631-1703). The flowing, regnal locks are each carefully planned and painstakingly engraved. Only with a full and clean strike can the true beauty of Roettiers' efforts be appreciated. The richness of strike is also seen, importantly, in the elephant and castle mark.

Tilting the coin slowly around in one's grasp, centuries of beauty spring to life before the beholder's eyes. A shimmering and full lustre dances over rich, ochre toning as the crisp and fully defined strike appears decades ahead of its time. No photo or video will ever capture the beauty of a lustrous coin in light, let alone a rarity such as this; and only with the coin before us can the presence of its history be felt. This coin was likely struck to grace a court favourite of the King and one can only imagine the noble, valiant, or murderous hands that may have held it.

The coin exhibits just one spot of weakness that is on the lowest tip of the bust. This weakness is ubiquitous and consistently more severe across the issue. Another common problem with the issue is adjustment marks that

considered in some ways a presentation piece having been struck to serve a purpose more symbolic than useful. It is quite possible however that this specific example was struck with a greater level of care, and perhaps even with greater intentions. There is a quality about this example that evokes a modern specimen strike. The edge beading is unusually clear and well placed. The locks of hair are unusually well defined. The golden blank on which it is struck is unusually broad. It is in an unusually fine state of preservation showing it has been treated with upmost care since its striking. The exact, unique nature of this piece cannot be described for certain, although it can be said that its beauty is unparalleled within the issue. It is not uncommon for top dealers and auction houses to have only publicly handled one or two examples of this coin in any grade, or no examples at all. The institutions who have publicly handled an example of this calibre are just those listed in this coin's provenance.

The Samuel King Survey of 2005 found that just 38 examples of this issue had sold over a 45-year period making this the second rarest five guinea piece of James II. SPINK noted in 2003, that this example was not just the finest they had seen of the issue, but the finest of all James II five guinea pieces they had seen. Keep in mind that SPINK, founded 1666, predates this coin.

1770.-

Milled Coinage of England (1950) describes the issue as 'VR' for 'very rare' and Maurice Bull (2022) awards the issue a rating of 'R' for 'rare'; although with perhaps fewer than fifty examples extant Bull's assessment is overly cautious.

It is a common view that tangible assets, particularly rare and fine coins, perform well in times of economic adversity. However, the highest end of numismatics has consistently seen far superior growth that is vastly out of proportion to the rest of the market. The reason for this is simple: rarity, beauty, and historical importance as traits become exponentially rarer with each step forward in quality. As the most resourceful of collectors and investors jostle for the best of the best, the rest of the market watches on as the upper echelon of coinage drifts further and further ahead of the fleet. This coin has long been aboard those flagship vessels.

As Sir Isaac Newton oversaw the workings of The Royal Mint, master jeweller turned legendary engraver John Croker produced this extremely rare pattern coin. So few are examples of this issue that only six have publicly traded in the last two decades. With an example gracing the Montagu Collection, Murdoch Collection, Douglas-Morris Collection, Pittman Collection and Slaney Collection, this is clearly a must-have for any serious collection of British coinage.

This coin is a beautiful example of an extremely rare and sought-after pattern issue. Only around six examples have publicly traded hands in the last 20 years. Richard Yeo's masterful depiction of a youthful George III exists here in prime form, with a strong strike, just minimal cabinet wear, and beautiful, glowing surfaces. The subtle shape of the King's features are accented by a satiny lustre that creates a touching realism. This simple naturalism is complimented by the precise and intricate locks of hair, accented by the radiant grooves which surround each lock. This phenomenal pattern would have pride of place in any world-class collection.

Extremely Rare, Unrecorded Overdate, Single Finest (NGC & PCGS) NGC Mint State 64. Exceptional. Boldy struck for issue with just light cabinet friction. Very lustrous. Regular issue extremely elusive in this condition, and given the overdate, extremely rare.

- Graded NGC MS64, this stands as the single finest graded overdate of the issue and is joint finest graded with all regular examples. No 1773 guinea of any type is graded higher.
- Not only is this one of if not the finest 1773 guineas available to collectors but it also features an unusual and unrecorded overdate, making this coin extremely rare.
- Featuring a masterful bust by the great Richard Yeo that can only be fully appreciated in such immaculate condition.

This is an exceedingly special coin. A regular issue 1773 guinea in this condition would be exceptional in its own right as they are so seldom seen. However, this is an unrecorded overdate in a series where overdates or not all too common. Bull (2020) references two overdates for the 1773 guinea: 3 over 2, and first 7 over 1. Both are considered rare. This overdate is 3 over a misstruck 1. There is no record in literature or auction archives of such an overdate existing and as such this example is exceedingly rare and of the highest interest.

Visually, the coin is extremely pleasing. Lustre on a guinea of this period is a sight for sore eyes and this example has a hearty dose of silky, swirling shimmer. So frequently busts of this period are seen poorly struck. This is not the case here, with the coin featuring Yeo's masterful bust struck full and proud. The grade of Mint State 64, fittingly awarded, is the highest ever gifted to the issue (overdate or not). It is worth noting that PCGS have no 1773 examples grade above an MS62. An extremely common problem with this issue is die flaws that pockmark the surfaces of even high-grade examples. Numeric grading does not take this fully into account and the example offered here stands out as a relatively unflawed example featuring

clear and smooth devices. Absolutely choice.

Clearly, this coin is a wonderful opportunity to bolster any top-class collection or upgrade the standard of a collection that is just blooming. Coins such as these are worthy of the upmost attention and will take pride of place wherever they find their home.

- Rated R5, extremely rare. There are only 6-10 examples.
- One of two examples graded as Proof 64. None graded higher by either grading company.
- Impressive provenance stretching to 1953, including the Slaney Collection. This is an extremely rare pattern issue by the great Richard Yeo in his prime. Only five examples, including this one, have traded publicly in the last two decades. This particularly delicate and well-proportioned bust exists on no other issue. This is also the joint finest graded example of this unique bust. The svelte slopes of neck, cheek and shoulder are so perfectly and subtly engraved, giving the impression of freshly pressed snow. A velvet lustre shimmers and dances over each curve breathing life into the regnal depiction. Flipping the coin over, a bold and precisely engraved royal shield meets the eye. This contrast perfectly complements each side of the coin, accenting both the softness of royal flesh and the cold strength of aristocracy. All of this boldly stands out against beautifully reflective fields of a subtle olive tone that under direct light erupts into a blazing yellow. Truly a world class example, having graced the Dangar Collection, Slaney Collection and British Collection. Befitting only of the cream of numismatic collectors.

PCGS Proof 64 Deep Cameo. Truly breath-taking. The most famed of British coins in impeccable condition. Fully struck and gorgeously lustrous devices float in completely mirrored fields. To hold the coin close is to see yourself staring back. No wear and light handling marks as indicated by grade. Extremely rare and exceedingly sought after. 11 to 20 examples known. Equal finest graded (PCGS).

This coin is known as the Una and the Lion Five Pound piece. The design was derived from a poem, The Faerie Queene by Edmund Spenser in praise of Queen Elizabeth I published in 1590. In that poem Una is the personification of the "True Church" and also representative of Truth. At one she point tames a lion by her beauty and honesty; the lion then travels with her both as a guard and to undertake deeds. On the coin, by William Wyon, Una is Queen Victoria. She is wearing a crown and guiding the lion with her sceptre while holding an orb. It is a classic of the Victorian Age in both style and sentiment, and one of master engraver William Wyon's masterpieces, with a modest mintage in the hundreds. It was only minted on demand from the time it first appeared in the Coronation sets, only in Proof grade.

The issues the mint encountered with the Jubilee coins are well documented and were exacerbated by the pressure for the coins to be ready for the Queen's Golden Jubilee on 20 June 1887. Records show that 1,771,425 half-sovereigns were struck in 1887, but only 871,770, less than 50% of the total, were fit for circulation. To improve metal flow silver was included in the alloy, which makes all 1887 London Jubilee head half-sovereigns stand out for their lighter colour. 
